As a follow up to our letters of March 13, 2020 and March 19, 2020, in accordance with Executive Order N-33-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 19, 2020 to curb the spread of COVID-19, Spencer Valley School is CLOSED until further notice.

We remind you again that there are many sites set up around the county to provide school-aged children lunch. Currently the FREE LUNCH pick-up times and locations for our area are listed below:

- Julian High School between 11:30 – 12:00
- Mesa Grande "Old Dairy" bus stop between 11:30 – 12:00
- Shelter Valley Community Center between 11:30 – 12:00
- Butterfield Ranch bus stop between 12:15 – 12:30

Anyone between the ages of 2-18 can get a lunch. Just stop by and pick it up.

As you are aware, teachers are working hard planning for distance learning. More Information will provided later this week.

We are continuing work to address services for our students with disabilities and will directly contact parents/guardians of those students regarding services during this time.

We will remain in close contact with the San Diego County Office of Education and local public health officials throughout the duration of this closure and will provide updates to families as appropriate.

We encourage you to stay informed of the situation by regularly checking updates from San Diego County Public Health Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time of uncertainty and concern. We will continue to communicate regularly as we learn new information.
