**Education Code Section 60119
2015-2016 Resolution on Sufficiency of Instructional Materials**

RESOLUTION REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

Whereas, the governing board of Spencer Valley School District/County Office of Education, in order to comply with the requirements of *Education Code Section 60119* held a public hearing on October 7, 2015, at 5:00 P.M. which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the end of the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

Whereas, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, and members of the community in the public hearing, and;

FOR A FINDING OF SUFFICIENT INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

Whereas, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district/county office of education, and;

Whereas, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

Whereas, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- **Mathematics** –
Everyday Mathematics, McGraw Hill Education, Grades Pre-K-6
CPM (College Preparatory Mathematics), CPM Educational Program, Grades 7-8

- **Science –**


Whereas, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes when offered, and;

Whereas, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;



PASSED AND ADOPTED this 7th day of October 2015 at the regular meeting of the Spencer Valley School District.




